Founded in 1991, the Tennessee Urban Forestry Council (TUFC) is Tennessee’s nonprofit voice for trees.

Through education, recognition programs, professional development, and public outreach, TUFC works to inspire action, exchange knowledge, foster collaborations, and advance awareness of the many benefits trees provide to Tennessee’s communities. Our work equips professionals, volunteers, and community leaders with the training, tools, and networks needed to grow and sustain healthy urban and community forests.

As a membership-driven organization, we value the camaraderie and connections that naturally develop when Tennessee’s tree people come together to learn, share expertise, and support one another’s work. We consider it a privilege to be the convener and connector that enables these relationships to blossom, and our partners are an integral part of building this community.

TUFC is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit funded through member support, program revenue, private donors, and a grant from the TN Division of Forestry. Operating with a small staff, a working Board, and dedicated volunteers, TUFC maximizes its resources to deliver meaningful statewide impact.

Arborist Training & Workshops

Advances professional development for aspiring and practicing arborists. Options include the ISA Certified Arborist Prep Course, TRAQ training, PPQ training, and Pre-Conference Workshops.

Canopy Connections

Social and educational gatherings (~50 attendees per event) designed to strengthen regional peer networks and expand awareness of local urban forestry issues.

Tennessee Tree Stewards

Trains and empowers engaged volunteers to care and advocate for trees in their communities. Builds capacity for local volunteer workforces and encourages green industry career exploration.

Custom Partnerships

Canopy Partners invest more than \$5,000 annually and collaborate with TUFC on high-impact initiatives. These are distinct from the annual and conference sponsorship packages.

Potential impact areas could include:

- Educational resources and outreach materials for the public
- Creative digital content and storytelling
- Scholarship and financial assistance funds for aspiring green industry professionals
- Youth education or workforce development programs
- Small grant funds to support community projects
